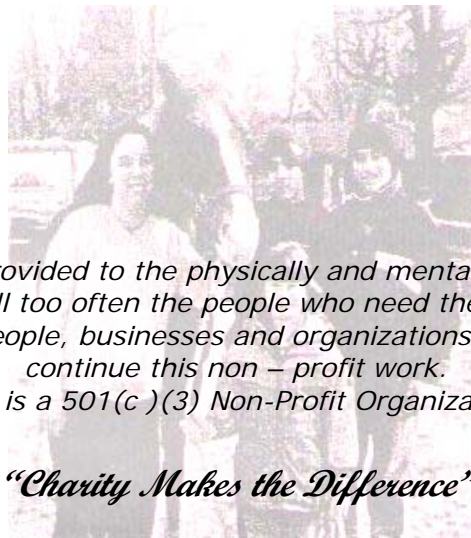
We ask that you join with your Brothers and Sisters to purchase a **Journal Ad** to help support the Knights of Columbus in all our charitable works.
