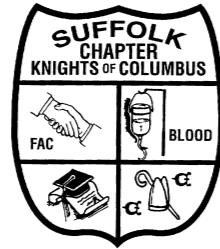

FATHER KENNETH G. MURPHY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Purpose: To provide Financial Assistance to dependent children of Knights of Columbus and their affiliates for the furthering of their Catholic High School education.

Scholarship Awards: Scholarships are awarded based upon the scholastic aptitude of the student's within Church and Community. The scholarship is awarded without consideration of financial need. The scholarship is a one time award and is available ONLY to incoming Freshman. Four (4) scholarships will be awarded as follows: One (1) each of \$1,000 and three (3) each of \$500 to eligible applicants from Suffolk County councils.

Requirements:

1. Applicant MUST be a son, daughter, grandchild or legal ward of a Knight of Columbus, Columbiette or Ladies Auxiliary member in good standing; a Squire or Squirette in good standing. Children of deceased members whose demise occurred while in good standing are also eligible.
2. Acceptance in a Catholic High School for the year beginning September of the year of application. Proof of acceptance will be required.
3. All applications MUST bear the Council Seal and the signature of the Grand Knight and the Financial Secretary verifying good standing or certifying the Auxiliary signatures.
4. Signature of Parent or Guardian is required to certify the accuracy of all information on the application and acceptance of the requirement for objective proof, if required.
5. A letter of recommendation from a Grand Knight of the Suffolk jurisdiction specifying the STUDENTS involvement in Church and/or Community activities.
6. A letter of recommendation from a Priest, Deacon, Nun or Religious Brother specifying the STUDENTS involvement in Church activities.
7. A letter of recommendation from an Educator of the currently attended school specifying the STUDENTS scholastic and activity achievements in the school.
8. A transcript of the STUDENTS final marks for the grades 6 and 7 and the MID-YEAR grades for the 8th grade.
9. A 100 word composition, written by the STUDENT, describing their understanding of the Knights of Columbus and their activities within the student's Church and Community.
10. THE DECISION OF THE COMMITTEE IS FINAL.

Other Related Information:

1. For purpose of filing, the location of the Council decides the County of residence.
2. A student entering a 9th grade in a Catholic High School may apply for both a Financial Grant and a Scholarship Award, but may receive ONLY one or the other. This selection will not affect their right to apply for a Financial Grant the following year.
3. Payments of Scholarship Awards are made annually, directly to the Catholic High School in part payment of tuition.
4. Scholarship announcements will be made at the June Chapter meeting. Only winners will be notified.
